## **Introduction**

It once again gives us great pleasure to invite you to take part in this popular event. The run will take you from Worsley Old Hall to Stanley Park Blackpool over some of the finest roads in the northwest of England.

As usual we have produced a route bringing in new areas to explore plus some popular places revisited. The start is at Worsley Old Hall and the comfort break is at the Duke of Wellington on the Grane Road. Lunch is again at Fulwood Barracks with the finish at the Italian Gardens in Stanley Park. You have a choice of routes to suit your vehicle.

The event is a Touring Assembly and Concours De Elegance which are organised under an MSA Certificate of Exemptions (CoE105168 and 104031). The route has been cleared with the Route Liaison Officers for the counties we are visiting. The Concours De Elegance will be held at The Italian Gardens in Stanley Park.

This year the entry fee includes hotpot for two at the lunch halt. Unfortunately the caterers have increased the costs this year and this has led to an increase in the entry fee. Additional lunch tickets may be ordered, if required, for £7.00. Due to security issues at Fulwood we will need the names of all entrants and passengers. Tickets may also be purchased for cream teas at the Italian Gardens. There is also a comfort halt where refreshments may be purchased at the Duke of Wellington control. Food and drink will be available at the finish.

The event is open to all types of car and age including Veteran, Edwardian (a special shorter route starting from Fulwood is available for these classes) Vintage, Classic and Cherished.

## **Manchester to Blackpool Classic Car Run**

### **Regulations**

1. Lancashire Automobile Club Ltd will promote a Touring Assembly on Sunday June 10th starting at Worsley Old Hall, Worsley, M282QT at 09.00 and having a route taking in the Ribble Valley, East Lancashire and the Fylde. The event will finish at The Italian Gardens, Stanley Park, Blackpool.
2. The event is open to all classic and 'cherished' car owners for an entry fee of £40.00 (non member) or £35.00 (LAC Member). The entry will cover full route instructions in the form of a tulip Road Book pack, Rally plate and a Route Information Book giving interesting information about the places you pass through. The maximum number of entries is 100.
3. Eligible vehicles: The event is open to all Veteran, Vintage, Classic Cars and other cherished cars of any age. We have no date restrictions.
4. The event will involve 3 routes varying from 80 to about 100 miles. All the roads used will be tarmac. There will be no competition on the public highway. Entrants may choose one of the three routes. Direct, Scenic or pre 1919. Please indicate on entry form. Control opening times allow for average speeds of 12mph (pre 1919) 19mph on the 'Direct Route' and 26mph on the "Scenic Route".
5. There will be 'neutral sections' with time-allowance for rest halts. The organiser's mileages and timings will be deemed to be correct.
6. Driving standards will be of the highest order. All Entrants undertake to comply with these Regulations by the fact of their entry to the event.

7. The entry fee includes hotpot at the lunch halt for the driver and one passenger. Additional tickets may be purchased. Please indicate numbers required on the entry form and include with your remittance.
8. The aim of the event is fun and the enjoyment of driving in the company of other enthusiasts.
9. The entry list closes on May 23<sup>rd</sup>. Due to security requirements entries after this date will not be accepted.
10. Final instructions detailing the start etc. will be emailed on June 1st
11. Because this event is being run on the public highway, it is essential, by law, that cars have the correct insurance cover, please check your cover carefully. Entrants and drivers must have a valid insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act and the relevant laws applicable in the United Kingdom, and European Union.
12. All Entrants and crew will be required to '*sign-on*' at the Start of the event to confirm their acceptance of all conditions applying to the event. This will also bring them into line with the MSA Regulations

Entry for this run also includes entry for a simple Concours event at the Finish.

The Concours Awards will be as follows:

All entrants to the Concours will receive a Commemorative medal at Stanley Park.

There is no requirement for entrants to take part in the road section to qualify for judging in the Concours section of the event.

Main Awards

1. Blackpool Corporation Trophy and Replica: Selected by the Mayor of Blackpool (all Groups)
2. The Ken Hadley Trophy: Best Performance in Concours (all Groups)
3. Trophy: Best Performance in Concours Group 1 (Cars manufactured up to 31<sup>st</sup> December 1919)
4. Trophy: Best Performance in Concours Group 2 (Cars manufactured from 1<sup>st</sup> January 1919 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 1945)
5. Trophy: Best Performance in Concours: Group 3 (Cars Manufactured from 1<sup>st</sup> January 1946 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 1984)
6. Trophy: Best Performance in Concours Group 4 (Cars accepted by the organisers manufactured from 1<sup>st</sup> January 1985)
6. Trophy : Concours Judges award (All Groups)

No car can win more than one award. Whilst the replicas may be kept, the named Trophies are to be held by the recipient for one year only. Recipients of these trophies are responsible for their insurance, safekeeping, and return in good condition, in time for the following year's event.

Groups may be combined for the purposes of awards at the discretion of the organisers
