Classic Challenge 2015

The Lancashire Automobile Club organises a series of Classic events throughout the year. The Classic Challenge is open to all members of the Lancashire Automobile Club who take part in these events. The Challenge is open to drivers, navigators and organisers with trophies awarded at the Club's Annual Diner Dance and Prize Presentation on Friday 5th February at Mitton Hall.

This Challenge will be staged to promote interest in the Clubs' events and to encourage some friendly rivalry between members. Changes to MSA requirements means a slight change in format this year – we hope you will enjoy the new scoring system.

The Challenge enables drivers, navigators and organisers to claim points for each event. Points will be recorded on a simple scorecard which must be sent to the Championship Compiler, Chris Lee, before the 10th January 2016.

Rules

- Points may be claimed for each Lancashire Automobile Club Classic event by drivers, navigators and organisers who are fully paid up members of the Club on 25th October 2015.
- Organisers of events may claim points for starting and finishing events as set out below but not points for entering events.
- Lancashire Automobile Club Classic events are defined as:
 - Any LAC Social Event
 - St Georges Day Run 26th April
 - The Fellsman 9th May
 - Great Manchester to Blackpool Car Run 14th June
 - Coast to Coast Car Run 11th July
 - Highland 3 Day Classic Tour 18th – 20th September (see note below)
- Points will be awarded as follows:
 - Attending one LAC Social event in 2015 - 5 points
 - Entering event 5 points
 - Starting Road Event 15 points (see note on Highland 3 Day below)
 - Taking part in Concours 30 points
 - To classify as a starter the car entered must cross the start line of the event under its own power
 - To claim points entrants should fill in the attached 'scorecard'.
 - Scorecards must be sent to the Challenge Organiser on or before the 10 January 2016.
 - An award will be given to the Overall, Driver, Navigator and organiser with the highest scores. An entrant may only receive one award. Where a Driver or Navigator acts as an organiser on one event that score will count towards the overall score as a Driver or Navigator.
 - Any ties may be resolved by the Club Committee taking into account the type and condition of vehicle(s) used.
 - To receive an award the recipient must be present at the 2016 LAC Diner Dance on Friday 5th February 2016.

Starting Day One	15 points
Starting Day Two	15 points
Starting Day Three	15 points

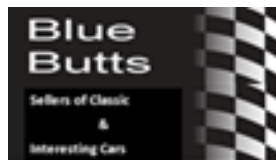
