Introduction

Please Note – Should we be unable to hold the event on this date the Lancashire Automobile Club will fully repay all entry fees.

Back in the early 1950's the Lancashire Automobile Club organised a navigational rally which took in most of the bridges on the Lancaster Canal between Preston and Lancaster. We couldn't organise a navigational rally these days but we can recapture the spirit of the original event with this non competitive run.

The event is a Touring Assembly organised under an Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption and the route has been cleared with the relevant Route Liaison Officers.

The entry fee includes a route book describing the 75 mile route in the style of a 1960's event. (Note we will not be issuing 'Rally Plates' for this event.).

We are starting and finishing at The Wheatsheaf PH in Garstang. Subject to government restrictions at the time of the event they hope to offer refreshments for entrants to purchase at the start and hopefully entrants will also be able to order a light meal on their return.

To provide social distancing we will ask entrants to arrive 10 mins before their start time and forward you signing on sheets, route and route information books as well as Covid indemnity forms. These should be printed off and signed prior to arrival at the start and handed to the marshal (who will be wearing appropriate PPE. The reduced entry fee reflects these changes. At the finish we ask you simply 'clock in' then depart to avoid groups forming.

The Route Book includes written route instructions. Whilst the event is non competitive and untimed the route has been devised so it can easily be completed at an average speed of 24 mph making it suitable for cars of most ages and capabilities.

The event is open to all types of car and age. We have a motto in Lancashire Automobile Club (1902) Ltd "If you cherish your car we cherish you!"

Rally of the Bridges Regulations

1. Lancashire Automobile Club (1902) Ltd will promote a Touring Assembly on Saturday May 22nd starting at The Wheatsheaf PH in Garstang at 11.00 and having a route of around 73 miles following the Lancaster Canal northwards and returning a little further inland.
2. The event is open to all classic and 'cherished' car owners for an entry fee of £15.00 (£5.00 for LAC members). The entry will cover full route instructions in the form of an easy to follow tulip Road Book, and Route Information Book (giving interesting information about the places you pass through). The maximum number of entries is 50.
3. Eligible vehicles: The event is open to all Classic Cars and other cherished cars of any age. We have no date restrictions.
4. The event will involve a route of about 75 miles in some of the most interesting areas in both the Fylde, Wyre and Ribble Valley All the roads used will be tarmac. There will be no competition on the public highway.
5. Driving standards will be of the highest order. All Entrants undertake to comply with these Regulations by the fact of their entry to the event.
6. The aim of the event is fun and the enjoyment of driving in the company of other enthusiasts.
7. The entry list closes on May 6th
8. Final instructions detailing the start times, signing on forms, indemnities and route books etc. will be emailed on May 16th
9. Because this event is being run on the public highway, it is essential, by law, that cars have the correct insurance cover, please check your cover carefully. Entrants and drivers must have a valid insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act and the relevant laws applicable in the United Kingdom, and European Union.
10. All Entrants will be required to present their completed 'signing-on' forms at the Start of the event to confirm their acceptance of all conditions applying to the event. This will also bring them into line with the Motorsport UK Regulations

Dear Member

Many sporting organisations have seen the necessity to review the level of exposure of both officials and members to ever increasing legal challenges. Particularly in the motoring/motorsport field, unforeseen events, some tragic, have occurred with significant consequences for all concerned.

Many charities and 'not-for-profit' organisations have been formed as, or have changed to become, a Company Limited by Guarantee in order to provide a much stronger level of financial protection. The guarantors of such companies are its members, but the company itself is a legal entity separate from its members who are financially responsible only to the amount of their guarantee.

It is very important to emphasise that the members' total financial liability to the company in the event of it being unable to pay its debts would be that of the amount of guarantee, in this case £10.00. It is worth saying at this point that the club has very healthy financial reserves.
