Hills and Dales Tour

Introduction

This Tour starts from the Lancashire Hills and finishes in the Yorkshire Dales taking in some fantastic roads and impressive scenery along the way. The finish is at Headlam Hall in North Yorkshire where Afternoon Tea (Sandwich and Scone and Coffee/Tea) awaits. If you wish to stay at Headlam Hall rooms are limited and early booking is advised.

The route starts from the Café Lazio in Samlesbury a familiar location for many of you. We leave the Café Lazio to go via Hurst Green, and Austwick to a coffee stop at The Helwith Bridge Inn and then Ribble Head, Buttertubs and on to Headlam Hall (DL2 3HA).

The event is a Touring Assembly organised under a Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption and the route has been cleared with the relevant Route Liaison Officers.

The entry fee includes a rally plate, route book, route information book and bacon butty and coffee at Café Lazio and sandwich and scones for two at Headlam Hall. If you have more than two people in your car you can purchase additional butties and Afternoon Tea; please talk to Jeff Chambers who will discuss your requirements.

The Route Book includes both classic 'Tulip' diagrams and written route instructions. Whilst the event is non-competitive and untimed, the route has been devised so it can easily be completed at an average speed of 24mph making it suitable for cars of most ages and capabilities.

Once again the LAC will be adopting the FBHVC 'Tree-V' environmental initiative that captures carbon dioxide generated by the entrants by contributing to the planting of trees in the UK. This will help to demonstrate the Club's environmental commitment to potential sponsors and local authorities.

The event is open to all types and ages of cars. We have a motto in Lancashire Automobile Club (1902) Ltd "If you cherish your car, we cherish you!"

Hills and Dales Tour Regulations

- 1. Lancashire Automobile Club (1902) Ltd will promote a Touring Assembly on Saturday June 21st 2025 starting at The Café Lazio at Huntley's PR5 0UN at 10.00 and having a route of around 100 miles in the Hodder and Ribble Valleys to a coffee stop at the Helwith Bridge Inn before travelling via Ribble Head and Buttertubs to the finish at Headlam Hall
- 2. The event is open to all classic and 'cherished' car owners for an entry fee of £90.00 (£80.00 for LAC members). The entry will include full route instructions in the form of an easy-to-follow Tulip Road Book, Route Information Book (giving interesting information about the places you pass through), Bacon Butty at Café Lazio (for two persons) and sandwiches and scones at Headlam Hall. The maximum number of entries is 70.
- 3. Eligible vehicles: The event is open to all Classic Cars and other cherished cars of any age. We have no restrictions on the age of a vehicle.
- 4. The event will involve a route of about 100 miles in some of the most interesting areas in the Hodder and Ribble Valleys and north Yorkshire. All the roads used will be tarmac. There will be no competition on the public highway. Tea, coffee and light refreshments will be available for purchase at the comfort halt at Helwith Bridge
- 5. Driving standards will be of the highest order. All entrants undertake to comply with these Regulations by the fact of their entry to the event.
- 6. The aim of the event is fun and the enjoyment of driving in the company of other enthusiasts.
- 7. The entry list closes on June 10th
- 8. Final instructions detailing the start times and route books etc. will be emailed to entrants on June 18th
- 9. Because this event is being run on the public highway, the law requires that cars have the correct insurance cover, please check your cover carefully. Entrants and drivers must have a valid insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act and the relevant laws applicable in the United Kingdom.
- 10. All Entrants will be required to complete '*signing-on*' forms at the Start of the event to confirm their acceptance of all conditions applying to the event. This will also bring them into line with the Motorsport UK Regulations.

11. Entries will be via the on-line portal using your Credit/Debit card. The 'NatWest Tyl' process is totally secure. Just click here to go to the Lancashire Automobile Club 'Hills and Dales Run' page in the events diary and complete the required entry information.
